Please read the following information carefully – particularly the events and fees information.

TERM DATES: Monday 10 February to Saturday 12 April

We will be having an OPEN DAY at the studio, on Saturday 8th FEBRUARY, between 10am – 4pm for anyone wishing to pop in to pay fees, check class enrolments or buy/sell dancewear etc.

OPEN - TO - OBSERVERS WEEKS:

Our classes are only open for observation 1 out of every 3 weeks. The first week of term is always open, then the following two are usually closed and so on. (This can vary during the different Terms).

OPEN WEEKS FOR TERM 1: 10 - 15 February, 3 - 8 March, 24 - 29 March. For the rest of the time they are closed classes (meaning no observers).

EVENT CALENDAR FOR 2025: - some of these dates are tentative only (they could change) Saturday 8th February 10am - 4pm - OPEN DAY: Pay fees, buy or sell uniforms etc and check out class availability.

later when we know which venue we are using).

Our END-OF-YEAR show dates depend on which venue we will use. Ideally, we'd love to use Avondale College again this year, but renovations are very likely to be happening, so we will find out later in the year and let everyone know. IF we use Avondale College (Avcol) the rehearsal and show dates will be as follows:

Rehearsals 28, 29, 30 Nov. The shows would then be on Saturday 6 December. If we end up having to use Green Bay High School, the rehearsal/show dates would be: Rehearsals 27, 28, 29, 30 Nov, & Shows on 6 & 7 December.

*Please put ALL the above rehearsal and show dates into your calendars now, so that you don't accidentally double book yourselves. All students MUST be available for ALL dates if committing to the show.

TERM 1 FEES: Fees for Term 1 are as follows:

30-minute class = \$90 per Term 45-minute class = \$115 per Term 60-minute class = \$130 per Term 75-minute class = \$155 per Term

IMPORTANT: Please note that due to some people continually paying their fees late (or not at all), we have a 'Late Payment Penalty". Any fees not paid by the end of week 3 will then incur a \$25 late payment fee which will be added to the total of your outstanding amount. If not paid by week 4 a "Stand Down from Classes" notice will be issued to encourage everyone to pay their fees on time.

Please ensure your term fees are paid within the first 3 weeks of term.

If paid by 16 February, deduct \$5 for early payment. If paying for more than one class, add up the total and then deduct 10%. We do not deduct or refund for classes missed. Our Term Fees Account is: ANZ 01 0186 0351940 00. Please put your child's first and last name as reference if paying online. If you would like to pay your fees in instalments by automatic payment please contact Kay on admin@dancewaitakere.co.nz. Part payments are online only. Full payments may be made in cash also.

CLASSES FOR 2025:

PRIVATE LESSONS 2025: If you are wishing to book some Private exam work lessons with your child's teacher – don't wait until 'closer to the exams'. BOOK NOW! Some people have already booked their spots for this coming Term, and the studio bookings are already filling up due to exam rehearsal bookings etc. GET YOUR PRIVATE LESSONS DONE EARLY, or risk missing out. Private Lesson prices are as follows. 30 min = \$30, 45 mins = \$45, 60 mins = \$60.

UNIFORMS: All items available for sale at our studio.

Please make sure your child wears the correct **WCSD** uniform to each class with hair tied up neatly. It is important to look and feel the part while you are in class and feel part of the class, not to mention it is good discipline and helps your teacher to correct posture and alignments. Students are asked not to wear 'baggy' tee shirts or clothing to class (except for Hip Hop students) as it restricts your movement and makes it harder for teachers to see if any postural corrections are needed. Acro students please do not wear baggy clothing as it is dangerous.

Jazz:

Pre Primary to Junior Jazz 3: WCSD lycra leotard/tights set and jazz shoes

Elementary 1 and up: WCSD black leotard and plain black WCSD ¾ or full length leggings

Ballet: WCSD black leotard, ballet tights and leather ballet shoes. Grade 3 upwards graduate to ribbons on shoes. Grades 5 and up require pointe shoes (if attending 2 lessons of Ballet per week).

Lyrical: WCSD black leotard/skirt combo

Contemporary: WCSD Black leotard with black WCSD ¾ leggings over the top

Hip Hop: Any clothing easy to move in and clean sneakers for classes but a WCSD T-shirt and black Trackpants & black sneakers will be required for exams.

Tap: WCSD black leotard with WCSD bike shorts and black tap shoes

Musical Theatre: Same as Jazz uniforms.

Acro: Tight fitted Fitness-wear. No baggy clothing. For exams – Jazz uniforms required.

WCSD T-shirts and Hoodies can be ordered any time at the studio. Order forms are on the front desk at the studio.

BAND:

Every single student should be on our BAND app. It is vital to keep up to date with your class work, homework your teacher may set, or any messages from your teacher. If you are not already on BAND, Please let us know and we'll invite you to join your classes. If you miss a class, it is up to you to catch up with the missed work on **BAND** so you're up to speed for the next week.

Parents when signing up **please use your child's name**, not yours. We have created a new BAND group for ALL WCSD students and need **everyone** to join this asap – see the QR code posters at the studio.
